Step 1: Line up the decimal points.

Step 2: Add zeros as placeholders if necessary.

Step 3: Write a decimal point in the answer.

Put the decimal point under the decimal points in the numbers you are adding.

Step 4: Add.

If you need to regroup, do it just as you would with whole numbers.

Subtracting Amounts of Money

Step 1: Line up the decimal points.

Remember to put the larger number on top.

Step 2: Add zeros as placeholders if necessary.

Step 3: Write a decimal point in the answer.

Put the decimal point under the decimal points in the numbers you are subtracting.

Step 4: Subtract.

If you need to regroup, do it just as you would with whole numbers.
