Adding Amounts of Money

Step 1: Line up the decimal points.

$$\begin{array}{r} \$ 1 \ . 5 5 \\ + \$ \ . 7 5 \\ \hline \end{array}$$

Step 2: Add zeros as placeholders if necessary.

$$\begin{array}{r} \$ 1 \ . 5 5 \\ + \$ 0 \ . 7 5 \\ \hline \end{array}$$

Step 3: Write a decimal point in the answer.

Put the decimal point under the decimal points in the numbers you are adding.

$$\begin{array}{r} \$ 1 \ . 5 5 \\ + \$ 0 \ . 7 5 \\ \hline \ . \end{array}$$

Step 4: Add.

If you need to regroup, do it just as you would with whole numbers.

$$\begin{array}{r} \$ \overset{1}{1} \ . \overset{1}{5} 5 \\ + \$ 0 \ . 7 5 \\ \hline \$ 2 \ . 3 0 \end{array}$$

Subtracting Amounts of Money

Step 1: Line up the decimal points.

Remember to put the larger number on top.

$$\begin{array}{r} \$ 1 . 5 5 \\ - \$ \quad . 7 5 \\ \hline \end{array}$$

Step 2: Add zeros as placeholders if necessary.

$$\begin{array}{r} \$ 1 . 5 5 \\ - \$ 0 . 7 5 \\ \hline \end{array}$$

Step 3: Write a decimal point in the answer.

Put the decimal point under the decimal points in the numbers you are subtracting.

$$\begin{array}{r} \$ 1 . 5 5 \\ - \$ 0 . 7 5 \\ \hline \quad . \\ \hline \end{array}$$

Step 4: Subtract.

If you need to regroup, do it just as you would with whole numbers.

$$\begin{array}{r} \$ \overset{0}{\cancel{1}} . \overset{1}{5} 5 \\ - \$ 0 . 7 5 \\ \hline \$ 0 . 8 0 \end{array}$$
