#### WHY LEAVES CHANGE COLOR


The green leaves on trees really have other colors in them. In the spring and summer, only the green color shows. That is because there is more green than any other color in the leaves. The green color is called chlorophyll (klor a fil). Leaves need warm sunlight to make chlorophyll.

When fall comes, there is less sunshine during the day. The days grow shorter. The air becomes cooler. The leaves cannot make enough chlorophyll to keep them green. Then the other colors in the leaves begin to show. Some leaves become yellow or orange. Other leaves show their red or purple colors.
