- 1. Use a ruler to draw dotted lines from each corner as shown in Picture A.
- 2. Cut along the dotted lines. Don't cut all the way through the center of the square.
- 3. Bend (don't fold) one corner of each triangle into the center of the square (Picture B).
- 4. Attach the pinwheel to the wooden stick with a pushpin.
- 5. Do not push the pushpin all the way in. Leave room for the pinwheel to spin.
- 6. Use small amounts of white glue to decorate your pinwheel with glitter.

The following instructions are wrong. Rewrite them to make them correct. Use the information from the art project above.

1.	You will need an eight-inch square of paper.
2.	Cut along the dotted lines all the way through the center of the square.
3.	Attach the pinwheel to the wooden stick with white glue.
4.	Fold each corner into the center of the square.
5.	Push the pushpin all the way in
6.	Use a lot of glue to decorate your pinwheel with glitter.
7.	Attach the pinwheel to a ruler.
