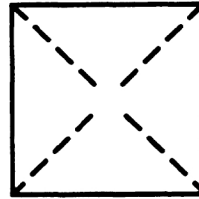


Pinwheel

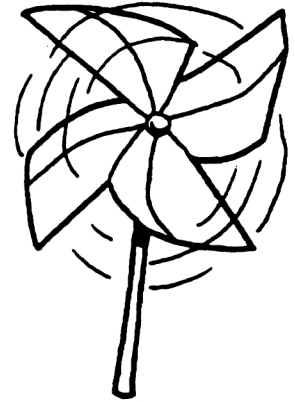
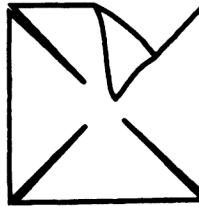
What you will need:

Scissors
Ruler
Pushpin
Wooden stick
Six-inch square of white or colored paper
Glitter, white glue

What to do:

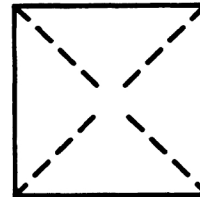
1. Use a ruler to draw dotted lines from each corner as shown in Picture A.
2. Cut along the dotted lines. Don't cut all the way through the center of the square.
3. Bend (don't fold) one corner of each triangle into the center of the square (Picture B).
4. Attach the pinwheel to the wooden stick with a pushpin.
5. Do not push the pushpin all the way in. Leave room for the pinwheel to spin.
6. Use small amounts of white glue to decorate your pinwheel with glitter.

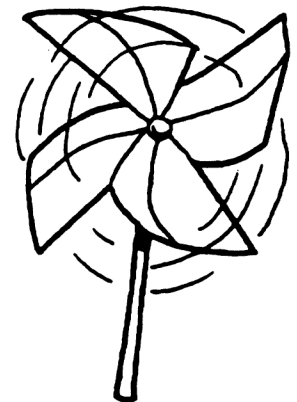
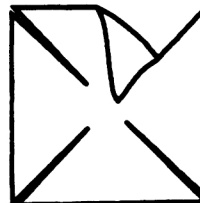
What you will need:

What to do:
